NEW ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT

The Londonderry School Board is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Daniel Black as the new Assistant Superintendent, effective July 1, 2017. Mr. Black will be stepping into that position replacing Scott Laliberte who has been promoted to the superintendency of the Londonderry School District. Mr. Black passed the rigors of the selection process first with an interview committee, followed by an on-site visit by a subgroup of the interview committee which included discussions with parents, faculty and administrators and a final interview with the School Board. Mr. Black received his Bachelor of Arts in English from Vanderbilt University, and his Master's Degree in Public Policy from Harvard University. He also recently completed his Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study in Educational Leadership from Plymouth State University.

Dan has been in education for a total of 16 years, starting as a teacher through Teach for America, at the P.S. Garza Elementary School in Donna Texas. He has had considerable experience in leadership as a principal of a charter school in the New York City Public School system, and in forming educational policy as an analyst in the Office of Administration and Finance for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Most recently, Dan has served as Assistant Superintendent for the Keene NH School District, where he assumed a full range of duties varying from budgeting to curriculum and instruction.

Outgoing School Board Chair Nancy Hendricks has stated that “Mr. Black’s wide range of experiences in school leadership and his student-centered approach to problem solving will make him an asset to our leadership team. His strong background in policy and instructional design will complement our district’s programs and services enabling our students to be college and career ready.”

Mr. Black stated that he is excited with his appointment and knows he is joining an outstanding leadership team with the promotion of Scott Laliberte. "I am honored to be joining the Londonderry School District. I look forward to being part of a community and school system that strives for and produces excellence for its students.
